Rasulullah ﷺ once passed by Saad ibn Abi Waqqaas رضى الله عنه and (noticing his excessive use of water in Wudhu) asked him, "What is this wastage?" Saad replied "Is there wastage in Wudhu also?" Rasulallah ﷺ said, "Yes, even if you are at a flowing river." (Ahmad)
