THE TEN DAYS OF ZUL - HIJJAH

Rasulullah has said, "There are no days during which pious actions are more beloved to Allah than on the first ten days of Zul-Hijjah." The Sahaabah henquired, "Is it greater than even Jihad in the path of Allah?" Rasulullah replied, "It is even greater than Jihad except that Jihad where a person sacrifices his possessions and even his life in the path of Allah." (Tirmizi)

The Fast of Youmul Arafah

The 9th day of Zul Hijjah is called *Yowmul-Arafah*. The fast of *Yowmul Arafah* has been prescribed by Rasulullah as a most meritorious act. According to the *Hadith*, the fast of this day becomes a cause of forgiveness for sins committed in the past and future year. (Muslim)

Clipping of nails & Removal of hair

It is Mustahab (preferable, but not obligatory) for a person performing Qurbani to abstain from trimming/removing hair or clipping nails from the commencement of Zul Hijjah (expected date: Tuesday (after Maghrib) 22nd August 2017) to the time he slaughters his Qurbani animal. Hence, hair and nails should be removed prior to the commencement of Zul-Hijjah.
