UNIQUE MOMENT FOR DUA

Sayyiduna Ubadah bin Samit reports that Rasulullah said: "Whoever's sleep is broken at night and recites (the Dua below) and thereafter asks Allah to forgive him or supplicates (for any need), Allah will forgive him and accept his supplication. If he thereafter makes Wudhu and performs Salaah, Allah will accept his Salaah."

Translation: There is no god besides Allah, the One, He has no partner and to Him alone belongs all kingdom and praise and He is able over everything. All praise is due to Allah, glory be to Allah and there is no god but Allah and Allah is the greatest, and there is no might and power except by Allah. (Bukhari)
