

Valentines of Lies & Heartbreak!

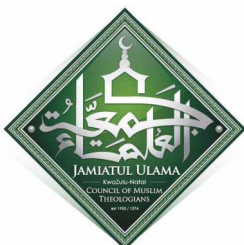
