

DUA TO BE RECITED ON THE NIGHT OF BARAAT (LAYLATUL BARAAT)

It is reported in a Hadith that Rasulullah صَلَّى اللهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ said to Hadhrat 'Aishah رَضِيَ اللهُ عَنْهَا: "On this night (Shabe Baraat) read this dua and teach it to others. Jibra'eel عَلَيْهِ السَّلَامُ taught this dua to me."

أَعُوذُ بِعَفْوِكَ مِنْ عِقَابِكَ وَأَعُوذُ بِرِضَاكَ مِنْ سَخِطِكَ
وَأَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنْكَ جَلَّ وَجْهُكَ لَا أَحْصِي ثَنَاءً عَلَيْكَ
أَنْتَ كَمَا أَثْنَيْتَ عَلَى نَفْسِكَ
