Note 3: Timetable accuracy +/- 1 minute. Note 4: Zuhr End and Asr start times are as per the Hanafi Mazhab. Note 5: When the sun loses its brightness (+/- 30 minutes before Maghrib) until sunset is a forbidden time. Only the Asr of that day may be performed during this time but it is sinful to do this.
