[Sunan Tirmidhi]












Ammaar Ibn Yaasir 🕸 said, "Whoever possesses three qualities will have completed his Imaan:


- treating others with fairness

Rasulullah said, "Shall I inform you of an act that is greater in status than Fasting, Salaah and charity?"


The Sahaba said, "Yes! Most certainly!"


Rasulullah said,
