

How Do We Know If Allah Ta'aala Desires Good For Us??

It is the Dua and wish of every Muslim that Allah Ta'aala does Khair (goodness) for them. The following Hadith Sharif vividly describes those conditions through which we can judge what Allah has decided for us.

“When Allah desires the well being of a nation, He appoints tolerant, good natured rulers over them, the learned scholars (Ulama) judge their cases (justly and with knowledge), and their wealth lies in the hands of the generous ones (so that all benefit through their generosity). And when Allah desires bad for a nation, (because of their iniquity) He appoints fools to rule over them, their ignorant ones judge their cases and their wealth lies in the hands of the stingy ones.” (Al-I'tidaal)

We should all question ourselves and ask, “How can we ensure that Allah Ta'aala decides favourable conditions for us?”

In our capacity is to ensure that our matters e.g. Marital disputes, estates, etc are decided by the Ulama and never handed over to Unislamic, irreligious judges, then this would be a step in the right direction to attain goodness from Allah Ta'aala.

Secondly the wealthy from amongst us should always have a big heart to spend happily in all good causes.
