Shockingly, reports have come to the Jamiat that Muslims, males and females that appear dressed as Deeni conscious Muslims are attending these events.

Rasulullah (Sallallahu Alaihi Wasallam) has warned us that when evils, like Music become prevalent, then violent winds, destruction and deformation, crime and insecurity should be anticipated. (Tirmizi, Hadith #: 2372)

A strong, serious and concerned appeal is made to all Muslims at large to abstain from attending such events. Parents should ensure that their children do not attend such events which are in fact, a grave threat to their chastity, Islamic morals and Imaan.
