1. Those who ascribe partners unto Allah
2. Those who harbour enmity against others
3. Those who consume alcohol
4. Those who disobey their parents
5. Those who commit murder
6. Those who break family ties
7. Males who wear their trousers, kurtas, etc. below their ankles

We should, at this time, take stock of ourselves. Are we of those that will be deprived of Allah's mercy on this night due to our evil actions? If we find ourselves guilty, then we must make an effort to correct the same so that we may also secure our forgiveness on Laylatul Bara'ah.
