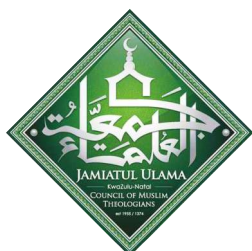


Masjid Etiquettes - Part 2

- 1) One should keep away from the Masjid those who do not respect the silence of the masjid, eg. Unsupervised children. (Tirmidhi)
- 2) It is unethical to introduce bad smells into the Masjid through one's breath or one's clothes. It is recommended to apply perfume and to clean one's mouth before entering the Masjid. (Ibn Majah)
- 3) One must be in a pure (paak) state to enter the Masjid.
- 4) It is a virtuous act to clean the Masjid. (Majma'uz Zawaid)
- 5) It is makrooh (disliked) to wear clothes with inanimate images or designs which can distract the attention of others performing Salaah.
- 6) It is prohibited to pass in front of a person performing Salaah. Nabi ﷺ has stated, ***"If the person passing in front of someone performing Salaah knew the seriousness of it, he would have waited for one hundred years."*** (Ibn Majah)
- 7) It is inappropriate to crack one's fingers in the Masjid unnecessarily.
- 8) It is Sunnah to recite the following Dua when leaving the Masjid:

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَسْأَلُكَ مِنْ فَضْلِكَ

O Allah, I ask You of Your favour. (Muslim)
