

Virtues & Etiquettes of visiting the sick

Rasulullah ﷺ said, "On the Day of Qiyaamah, Allah Ta'ala will announce: 'O son of Adam, I was sick yet you did not visit me. He will reply, 'O Allah, how could I have visited You when you are Rabbul aalameen? Allah Ta'ala will reply: 'Did you not know that so and so slave of mine was sick, and yet you did not visit him? Had you visited him you would have found Me by him. " (Sahih Muslim)

“When a Muslim visits a sick Muslim in the morning, seventy thousand Angels make Dua of forgiveness for him till dusk. If he visits him in the evening, seventy thousand Angels make Dua of forgiveness for him till the morning and he will be granted a garden in Jannah.” (Tirmidhi)

- ✿ A Sick person can be visited on any day. Due consideration should be given to the patients rest times and eating times.
- ✿ Don't overstay your visit but keep it short and brief.
- ✿ Try to make the patient happy and avoid asking questions related to their sickness.
- ✿ Reassure them and give them hope & encouragement.
- ✿ Rasulallah ﷺ said, 'Whenever you visit the sick or the dead person then supplicate for good because the Angels say “Ameen” to whatever you say.' [Sahih Muslim]



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
